



## PENNSYLVANIA OKs ELECTRONIC REMOTE TRAP CHECKING

On June 4, 2013 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF PENNSYLVANIA HOUSE BILL amended an act and **approved electronic trap monitoring** in the State. House Bill No. 891 states:

*IT SHALL NOT BE UNLAWFUL FOR A PROPERLY PERMITTED NUISANCE WILDLIFE CONTROL OPERATOR TO USE ELECTRONIC MEANS TO CHECK ON THE STATUS OF A TRAP WHILE ACTING PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED UNDER THE PERMIT.*
